Job Description - Weekend of Warriors

Goal

- Lead the entire camp in praising the Lord through song. (Psalm 100)
- Adequately and efficiently convey the Still Water Statement of Faith through an honest and clear explanation of the Gospel.
- Use your musical talent to engage kids and break down walls

Chain of Communication

- Report to the Programmer
- Collaborate with Speaker, Technology Director and Photographer

Pre-camp Responsibilities

- Be present for necessary staff training and conference calls
- Prepare yourself spiritually, mentally, and physically prior to coming out to camp
- Prepare lyrics to be projected throughout camp
- Provide song list to Technology Director at least 2 weeks prior to camp
- Communicate with speaker about focus for the week
- Provide or communicate to Camp Director all musical needs for the week
- Prepare ice breaker songs
- Prepare a group of trailers for fillers to be used on the screen for worship
- Talk through job description with Camp Director

Pre-Game Responsibilities (Saturday and Sunday Training)

- Meet with Programmer, Speaker, Technology Director, & Photo/Videographer
- Set-up all program equipment and sound check for camp intro
- Familiarize yourself with schedule to understand when, where, and what you will need to be doing at what time
- Familiarize yourself with lighting and sound

Camp Responsibilities

- Be present at morning staff devotionals (bible study)
- Be present at all activities where technological needs will need your assistance.
- Prepare music and lyrics for all Chalk Talks before hand
- Meet with Tech. Dir., Speaker and Worship Team for Sound Check and message planning before every team meeting
- Communicate to Tech. Dir. any technological needs that will be used during Team Meeting

Post Camp Responsibilities

- Coordinate breakdown of sanctuary
- Assist with the break down and clean up of camp
